spiritual writers. These are simply extra thoughts for each day that might assist the daily prayer and reflection.

1

May Jesus enable you to appreciate more and more, along with all the souls who love him with a sincere and pure heart, his most loving invitation: My yoke is easy and My burden is light. – With your very wounds God will heal you.

2

My yoke is easy and my burden is light. May this tender invitation of the Divine Master console you in trial. – All we have seen teaches us to trust the Creator for all we have not seen.

3

We must become familiar with the sufferings Jesus will be pleased to send us as if we were to live with them always. – **Give me faith, Lord, and let me help others find it**.

4

When you least expect to be set free, Jesus, who cannot bear to see you suffer for a long time, will take care of it. – **Turn to the Lord and pray for He is always near**.

5

Jesus will come to relieve and console you, by instilling new courage in your soul. – **Never fear shadows.** They simply mean there's light shining somewhere nearby.

6

When Jesus bestows a cross on one of his chosen ones, he strengthens that soul to such an extent that by bearing the weight of this cross the soul is relieved of it. – **May the Lord teach us to be generous and serve Him as He deserves.** 

7

We should turn our thoughts to heaven, out true homeland of which our earthly country is but a dim image. — Give and don't count the cost. Labor without seeking a reward except to know you are doing God's will.

8

Make every effort, with the divine assistance, at all times, amidst happy or sad events, the cheerful calm that becomes the true followers of the fair Nazarene. – A sure way to God is a humble knowledge of yourself than a search for learning.

9

We should be on the alert for every slightest sign of agitation, and as soon as we realize we have fallen into dejection, with must turn to God with filial confidence and abandon ourselves completely to him. – If we saw ourselves as our friends and other people see us, we would need an introduction.

10

If we keep our souls calm and peaceful in every difficult situation, we will gain much ground in the ways of God. – **Under the false, overloaded, glittering masquerade, there is in every person a noble nature**.

11

If we lose this peace, everything we do with a view to eternal life will yield little or no fruit. - It isn't a calamity to die with dreams unfulfilled, but it is a calamity not to dream.

12

Think no more of your past life, except in order to admire the heavenly Father's goodness which...did not want to reject you. — In the twilight of life, God will not judge us on our earthly possessions and human successes, but on how well we have loved.

13

With great care (God) wished to overcome your hardness and, winning you over with his grace, wanted and wants to demonstrate his power over you. – It is better to be patient than powerful.

14

Place all your cares in God alone because God greatly cares for you. – It is better to win control over yourself than over whole cities.

15

Let us consider Jesus' love for us and his concern for our well-being, and then let us be at peace. – Thank God for the handicaps of life that help you find yourself, your work, and your God.

16

Let us not doubt that (God) will invariably assist us with fatherly care against all our enemies. – Things turn out best for the people who make the best of the things that turn out.

17

If it were left to ourselves to remain on our feet, we should never be able to do it. – **Big shots** are only little shots who keep shooting.

18

How many times does (God) not stretch out his hand to us to arrest our headlong dash towards the precipice? – Happy are those who are not sad for what they do not have, but are grateful for what they do have.

19

How many times when we had abandoned (God), has he not readmitted us to his loving embrace? – Each is given a bag of tools, a shapeless mass, a book of rules. Each must/will make in life either a stumbling block or a stepping stone.

20

Grow always in Christian love and never tire of advancing in this which is the queen of all the virtues. – Make sure the thing you are living for is worth dying for.

21

Consider that you can never grow too much in this most beautiful virtue (Love). Love it very much. – Our lives are songs. God writes the words and we set them to music at pleasure.

22

Let (Love) be more than the apple of your eye, for it is most dear to our divine Master. Oh, yes, let us greatly esteem this precept of the divine Master, and all difficulties will be overcome. – Nothing here below is profane for those who know how to see. On the contrary, everything is sacred.

23

The virtue of love is exceedingly beautiful;, and to enkindle it in our hearts the Son of God was pleased to come down himself from the bosom of the eternal Father, to become like us. — While it is well enough to leave footprints on the sands of time, it is even more important to make sure they point in a commendable direction.

24

(The Son of God was pleased to come down) to become like us in order to teach us and make it easy for us with the means he left us to acquire this most eminent virtue (Love). – You can't turn back the clock, but you can wind it up again.

25

Let us ask Jesus insistently to give us this virtue (Love), and let us make greater and greater efforts to grow in it. – Times like these demand strong minds, great hearts, true faith, and ready hands!

26

You must be strong and cheerful in spirit, for the Lord is in the depths of your heart. – **Earth is crammed with heaven**.

27

Keep cheerful and don't be discouraged. Never permit your soul to be sad – to live with a sad scrupulous spirit – because Jesus is the spirit of sweetness. – **God's presence is not discerned at the time it is upon us, but afterwards when we look back.** 

Let us show ourselves to be worthy children of such a great Father. Jesus also invites us to climb to Calvary with him, so let us not refuse. – **God exists within us even more intimately than we exist within ourselves**.

29

In the course of life, mortifications will not be lacking for us either. Let us love them. Let us embrace them with a cheerful soul, and let us always bless the good God in everything. — **God is an unutterable sigh, lying in the depths of the heart**.

30

I thank the Lord that despite the fact that I suffer moments of real anguish, I am invariably cheerful. Meanwhile, I cast myself trustfully into the arms of Jesus, then let whatever he has decreed take place, and he must certainly come to my aid. – **The Mighty One has great things for me, and holy is God's name**.
