INTRODUCTION

Priest:

Brothers and sisters, on the occasion of the recent World Youth Day, the Pope often mentioned the need for a vital exchange between generations: faith must be lived, handed on, received and shared. The spirit of devotion to Padre Pio, and in particular of the Prayer Groups, is precisely that of sharing our faith, with simplicity, acceptance and above all willingness to listen. For all devotees of Padre Pio, but especially for members of the Prayer Groups, we begin a journey of education so that listening to and meditating on the Word of God may become the centre of our spiritual life. In this vigil, therefore, let us open our hearts to the richness of the Scriptures and to the light of the Holy Spirit to confirm us in these, our holy intentions.

A hymn may be sung invoking the Spirit of peace or a hymn praising peace.

Priest: Christ Jesus, who sacrificed yourself as a victim of reconciliation, come and give us

salvation

All: Christe eleison

I meditate on your precepts and consider your ways. I delight in your decrees; I will not neglect your word.



That same day Jesus went out of the house and sat by the lake. Such large crowds gathered around him that he got into a boat and sat in it, while all the people stood on the shore. Then he

told them many things in parables, saying: "A farmer went out to sow his seed. As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants. Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop—a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown. Whoever has ears, let them hear."

The disciples came to him and asked, "Why do you speak to the people in parables?".

He replied, "Because the knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of heaven has been given to you, but not to them. Whoever has will be given more, and they will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what they have will be taken from them. This is why I speak to them in parables: "Though seeing, they do not see; though hearing, they do not hear or understand. In them is fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah: You will be ever hearing but never understanding; you will be ever seeing but never perceiving. For this people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and I would heal them.'

But blessed are your eyes because they see, and your ears because they hear. For truly I tell you, many prophets and righteous people longed to see what you see but did not see it, and to hear what you hear but did not hear it.

"Listen then to what the parable of the sower means: When anyone hears the message about the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and snatches away what was sown in their heart. This is the seed sown along the path. The seed falling on rocky ground refers to someone who hears the word and at once receives it with joy. But since they have no root, they last only a short time. When trouble or persecution comes because of the word, they quickly fall away. The seed falling among the thorns refers to someone who hears the word, but the worries of this life and the deceitfulness of wealth choke the word, making it unfruitful. But the seed falling on good soil refers to someone who hears the word and understands it. This is the one who produces a crop, yielding a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown."

Praise to you, O Christ.

From a letter of Padre Pio to the Blessed Maria Gargani

A Maria Gargani, San Giovanni Rotondo 16th September 1916, Epist. III, 249....

. . .

Mental prayer or meditation is to be done as follows First prepare the point or subject you wish to meditate upon. There is not always a need to resort to a book to prepare the subject to be meditated upon, since every truth of our religion can and must be the object of meditation for the Christian soul. The soul habitually meditates on the life, passion and death of our Lord Jesus. No soul, however far it may be in the ways of God, should neglect this. Having prepared the matter to be meditated upon, place yourselves in the presence of God, humbling yourselves deeply to the consideration [of] who you are and to whom you present yourselves. Ask God for the grace to do the mental prayer that you are about to do well, so that you may obtain that fruit which God wants you to obtain from it. Finally, commend yourselves to the intercession of the Blessed Virgin, and to the whole heavenly court, that they may help you meditate well, keeping away distractions and temptations. Having meditated on the subject in all its particulars well, you then proceed to the propositions. Aim to amend yourselves of that defect which most keeps you from uniting with God and which is the cause of many other defects and sins of yours. You can also suggest you will practise such and such a virtue and then stop, when you have acquired it.

Finally, you will then move on to ask God for all those graces and helps that you feel you need. You will recommend all men to the Lord, both in general and in particular. You will pray for the restoration of the kingdom of God, for the propagation of faith, for the exaltation and triumph of our holy mother, the Church. You shall pray for the living; you shall pray for the dead; you shall pray for the infidels and heretics and for the conversion of sinners.

Having done all this, you will offer up your meditation and prayer, together with the offering of your whole self, as well as of all those people who are most dear to you, you will offer, I say, everything to God together with the merits of Jesus and of his and our Mother. And all this you will offer up through the hands of Mary most holy, of the Guardian Angel, of Saint Joseph, etc.

Lastly, a brief examination of how you have conducted yourself in the said meditation; and, recognising that you are defective, you will humble yourself before God, asking for his forgiveness by suggesting a way how to atone for this.

I strongly recommend you should keep to this habit of meditating on your own in this way twice a day. You will endeavour to spend if possible not less than half an hour each time. Again if possible, you will keep this practice in the morning, so as to prepare yourselves for the battle, and in the evening to purify your soul from every earthly affection that it has given itself to during the day.
