1 - In love it is Jesus Who delights me, while in suffering, it is I who give Him pleasure.

2 - I love the Cross, the Cross alone because I always see it on His shoulders.

3 - By this time Jesus is well aware that my entire life, my whole heart, is consecrated to Him and His sufferings.

4 - I am ready to be deprived forever of the tenderness which Jesus lavishes on me, as long as He does not hide His love from me.

5 - Take concern to have your heart be more pleasing to our Master day by day.

6 - Do things in such a way that this year is more fruitful in good works than last year.

7 - The years are passing away and we are approaching eternity.

8 - We need to redouble our courage and lift our souls to God, serving Him with more diligence in everything that our Christian vocation requires.

9 - My soul is aflame with the most keen desire to possess entirely.

10 - As in a mirror I am shown my whole future life as nothing but martyrdom.

11 - Without knowing why, and with unspeakable love, I yearn for death

12 - Despite all my efforts to be driven to ask God with tears in my eyes let me be taken from this exile.

13 - I feel inflamed with such a lively and ardent desire to please God.

14 - I am gripped by such a fear of falling into any slightest imperfection that I would like to flee from all dealings with creatures.

15 - Another desire rises up like a giant in my heart, the longing to be in the midst of all His people.

16 - (The desire rises up in my heart) to proclaim at the top of my voice who this great God of mercy is.

17 - One day we will recognize and value how great is the treasure that we earned from our earthly suffering.

18 - From generous souls and from those in love, God expects acts of heroism and fidelity.

19 - God expects acts of heroism and fidelity so that, after the ascent of Calvary, they may reach Mount

Tabor (of the Transfiguration).

20 - I am suffering very much. But thanks to our good Jesus, I still feel a little strength.

21 - When aided by Jesus, what is the creature not capable of doing?

22- I do not desire by any means to have my course lightened.
23 – Contemplating the Cross on His shoulders, I feel more and more fortified, and exult with holy joy.
24 – I feel the need to cry out: Give me what You command and command what You will.
25 – Do not allow the idea of my suffering to cast a shadow on our spirit, or to sadden your heart.
26 – We must hide our tears. Despite my unworthiness he has chosen (my tears) to help Him in the tremendous task f man's salvation.
27 – I desire to suffer more and more without the slightest consolation. And this consists of all my joys.
28 – How can I thank you for being so united with my sufferings?
29 – With the help of the good angel, that wretch (satan) has been vanquished this time in his wicked design.
30 – He (satan) wants to put an end to me at all costs and is using all his diabolical cunning to this end. But he will be crushed.
31 – I am at peace, resigned to everything, and I hope these diabolical tricks will not produce the disastrous effects that frightened me for a while.

Most Holy Rosary of Our Lady

St. Pio of Pietrelcina - Good Father and Spiritual Guide, your love for the Eucharist and for our Heavenly Mother Mary made you respect and love every facet of life that spoke of God and his loving care for all creation. Be with me as I open my heart to the Most Blessed Trinity and intercede for me that, through the intercession of Our Mother Mary and yours, I may be holy and always live in God's Most holy Will. Good Father, present me as your Spiritual Child to our Lady, as I open my heart to her, that she, in turn, may keep me and protect me in her Immaculate Heart, and lead me to Jesus, Her Son. Help me to see Jesus in the Eucharist I celebrate and receive so often. Pray that I, as Mary, may be a Tabernacle where Jesus finds a welcoming and a well-prepared place to dwell. On earth, Mary was the Monstrance who presented Jesus to the world, pray that I too may present Jesus in my life to all those whom I encounter on life's journey. Mary, my Mother, with Padre Pio as my companion in coming to you, intercede for me before the Blessed Trinity Whose Daughter, Mother and Spouse you are.

To Our Lady (adapted Prayer composed by St. Bernard) - Remember, O most compassionate Virgin Mary, never was it known, that anyone who fled to your protection, implored your assistance, or sought your intercession, was left unaided. Inspired with this confidence, I fly to you, O Virgin of virgins, my mother, to you I come, sinful and sorrowful. Mother of the Word Incarnate (assist me, that I may open my heart to the Word Incarnate and, like you, open my life to Christ, that I may live with, in, and for Jesus, as you did.) Despise not my request, but in your clemency, hear and answer me.
